Salish Soils employs a state of the art composting process that uses "Gore" technology.

Our excellent technicians produce a Class A Compost that is approved by the Ministry of Environment for Certified Organic Growers!!

Our facility receives Green Waste which along with Fish Finds, is the basis of our excellent grow medium.

In 2014 a Curbside Food Collection pilot was implemented. This waste stream is blended with forest finds to produce a unique and nutritious blend of natural, organic soil amendment.

Wood Construction Waste is accepted at our depot, where the material is chipped and sent to Port Mellon for biomass energy production.

We are really excited to embrace yet another transformation of a community waste product into a useful and life enhancing soil amendment!

In Spring 2015 the Salish team will begin taking dewatered biosolids from the Sechelt Water Resource Center to a **separate** site for compost preparation. The resulting material will be composted according to the Provincial standards to produce a Class A "Biosolids Compost" This compost is suitable for unrestricted use except for Certified Organic Growers. We are very proud for the community of Sechelt to demonstrate its care for the Earth in the responsibility of recycling our waste.

Our Fresh New Recycling Depot is organized and tidy and is popular with residents who enjoy the friendly experience.
