

## Equipment Operator

### Functional Summary

Reporting to the operations manager, the equipment operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the equipment. Heavy equipment on site includes loaders with mounted hydraulic powered buckets, excavators, a rock truck, and a grinder which is used to transport soil, aggregate, or other materials, feed hoppers, and stock piles of material.

### Key Responsibilities include

#### Safety

- Operate heavy equipment in a safe and appropriate manner
- Promote, execute, and adhere to the company's safety program and encourage all co-workers to adopt safety as a culture
- Attend safety meetings
- Work in a safe, responsible manner to not injure oneself or endanger the wellbeing of others

#### Equipment Operation

- Operates heavy equipment and other related duties as required
- Perform daily maintenance and safety checks of equipment including routine cleaning
- Understands and follows directions from operations manager as to work area
- Maintains constant communication by radio

#### Teamwork

- Participate as a vital team member and contribute towards the success of the company
- Promote a team approach and maintain respectful communication with all co-workers and leaders to exchange information and gather ideas
- Must ensure a solid understanding of and comply with the principles of the company's code of ethics
